Purpose of the Role

The Worship Coordinator will lead, develop and oversee the musical life of the church, enabling the congregation to encounter God and grow in faith through Spirit-filled and Christ-centred worship. This role combines leadership, musical ability, pastoral encouragement, and collaboration with church teams to ensure worship is both vibrant and accessible. The appointed candidate will take a creative lead in morning services, utilising a strong musical ability, to blend a mix of traditional hymns and modern contemporary songs into our sung worship. The Worship Coordinator would also be part of the team delivering these services as needed.

St Andrew's benefits from a small group of highly committed, open-minded musicians who form the music team, attending on a weekly basis to support the delivery of sung worship within the church. The role will involve coordinating the team to lead the congregation in spirit-enthused weekly worship, as well as collaborating with other service leaders in the discipleship of the congregation.
